Schaefer, Charles. (2019). Essential play therapy techniques. London: The Guilford Press.

This book presents 58 play therapy techniques that

belong in every child clinician's toolbox. The authors draw from multiple theoretical orientations to showcase powerful, well-established approaches applicable to a broad range of childhood problems. Activities, needed materials, and variations of each technique are succinctly described.

Each chapter also includes a historical perspective on the technique at hand, a rationale explaining its therapeutic power, and a review of relevant empirical findings.



Stroh, Linda K. (2019). The basic principles of effective consulting. London: Routledge.

The seventh edition provides clear coverage experimental,







Goodyear-Brown, Paris. (2019). Trauma and play therapy. London: Routledge.

This work synthesizes new developments in the study of children's trauma recovery to assist clinicians

combining play therapy with other powerful ways of addressing the needs of hurt children. The TraumaPlay<sup>TM</sup> model, equips practitioners to manage and adapt aspects of the play therapy place and process in order to help children tell their stories while draining the emotional toxicity from traumatic experiences. Chapters explore the neurobiological and developmental foundations of play therapy as well as strategies for navigating children's trauma in relation to specific aspects of play therapy such as sensory integration, metaphor, and humor.



McIntosh, Maureen (2019). Leadership and diversity in psychology. New York: Routledge.

This book explores topic the leadership and diversity from a range of

different perspectives. The authors draw from professional experience and research to support their reflections on leadership with diverse populations, leadership in organizations and developing leadership style.

Incorporating up-to-date research concerning current trends towards integrative work, the book emphasises practitioners' reflections of their own experience. It reflects the focus towards more pluralistic/integrative practice, which has moved away from traditional orientations involving specific ways of

health professionals an integration of creative and playful approaches and solution-focused therapy.

The author presents developmentally appropriate and expressive alternatives to oral communication including sandtray, writing, puppetry, drawing and coloring, photography, and music.

The text divides chapters into specific stages of therapy—beginnings, searching for treasure, setting goals, and ending the session—with creative techniques offered in each section.

### Reese, Gerhard. (2019). The psychology of globalization. Identity ideology and action. London: Academic Press.

The Psychology of Globalization: Identity, Ideology, and Action underpins the necessity to focus on the psychological dimensions of globalization. Overviewing the theory and empirical research as it relates to globalization and psychology, the book focuses on two key domains: social identity and collective action, and political ideology and attitudes. These provide frameworks for addressing four specific topics: (a) environmental challenges, (b) consumer culture, (c) international security, and (d) transnational migration and intra-national cultural diversification.

Arguing that individual social representation and behavior are altered by globalizing processes while they simultaneously contribute to these processes, the authors explore economic, political and cultural dimensions.

### Beer, Laura E. (2019). Using music in child and adolescent psychotherapy. New York: The Guilford Press.

There is growing evidence for the powerful role that music plays in enhancing children's cognitive, social, and emotional development. Written for a broad audience of mental health professionals, this is the first book to provide accessible ways of integrating music into clinical work with children and adolescents. Rich case vignettes show how to use singing, drumming, listening to music, and many other strategies to connect with hard-to-reach children, promote self-regulation, and create opportunities for change.

Using Music in Child and Adolescent Psychotherapy

The book offers detailed guidelines for addressing different clinical challenges, including attachment difficulties, trauma, and behavioral, emotional, and communication problems. Each chapter concludes with concrete recommendations for practice; an appendix presents a photographic inventory of recommended instruments




### Dummett, Nicky. (2019). Overcoming teenage low mood and depression. New York: Routledge.

# Effectiveness of child-centered play therapy among marginalized children.


Abstract: Marginalized children are often excluded from mainstream social, economic, cultural, and political life because of ethnicity or poverty. These children are more likely to have behavior problems that place them at risk later in life. The impact is evident at an early age. The purpose of this article was to review the literature that examined the impact of child-centered play therapy (CCPT) conducted with marginalized children. The literature was reviewed with regard to the results of the studies, the outcome variables used, the identification of who completed the assessments about the children, and the ethnicity of the play therapists who conducted the interventions. The findings demonstrated that CCPT is effective for marginalized children, externalized behaviors are most frequently assessed, teachers most frequently completed the assessments about the children, and the ethnicity of the play therapists is not usually reported. The results are considered in terms of implications for play therapists and future research.

### Stone, Jessica. (2019). Integrating technology into modern therapies. New York: Routledge.



The book also offers suggestions for how technology can be used in hospitals, as well as with migrant, refugee, and homeless populations. Combining theory and research with a wealth of case studies and practical resources, this book will be relevant to all mental health, speech and language, and child life specialists.



### Sommerville, Jessica A. (2017). Social cognition. Development across the life span. New York: Routledge.

Social cognition is organized according to two central themes that address issues of continuity and change both at the phylogenetic and the ontogenetic level. First, it addresses to what extent social cognitive abilities and behaviors are shared across species, versus abilities and capacities that are uniquely human. Second, it covers to what extent social cognitive abilities and behaviors are continuous across periods of development within and across the life span, versus their change with age.

This volume offers a fresh perspective on social cognition and behavior, and shows the value of bringing together different disciplines to illuminate our understanding of the origins, mechanisms, functions, and development of the many capacities that have evolved to facilitate and regulate a wide variety of behaviors fine-tuned to group living.





### Salomonsson, Bjorn. (2016). Dialogues with children and adolescents. A psychoanalytic guide. New York: Routledge.

Psychoanalytic work with children is popular, but the sophisticated language used in psychoanalytic discourse can be at odds with how children communicate, and how best to communicate with them. This book shows how these aims can be achieved for the most effective clinical outcome with children from infancy up to late adolescence.

Author draw on extensive case material which reveals the essence of communication between child and therapist. They enfranchise the patient of all ages as an equal participant in the therapeutic relationship. Presented in letter form the cases contain no professional terms. Only the final chapter contains theoretical commentaries applicable to each case. These terms and theories help to explain a child's behaviour, the analyst's technique and the background to the disorder.
