Vasilikie Demos. (2021). Gender and generations: continuity and change. Bingley: Emerald Publishing Limited.

This book focuses on the ways in which gender interacts with generation. Developed as the contributors and editors lived through the Covid-19 pandemic, the chapters offer a timely examination of gender-related changes that have occurred against the backdrop of changing socio-dynamics such as increasing and decreasing fertility and the aging of populations, and now, potentially, a global pandemic.

Muravyeva, Marianna. (2021). Parricide and violence against parents: a cross-cultural view across past and present. New York: Routledge.

This book takes a historical and criminological approach to the research on parricide and violence against parents, placing the research in the context of social development from the 1500s to contemporary society, and giving a global overview and comparison.

Chapters examines parricide and violence against parents as historically and culturally sensitive phenomena. It offers evidence on a seemingly rare subject from different eras, areas, and cultures, and then uses the cross-disciplinary data to produce a new, systematic insight for the reader. Case studies shift the discussion from the contemporary focus on adolescent to parent abuse, to examining the sources of conflict during life cycles of parents and their offspring.

A historical approach illuminates the variations in conflicts between parents and their offspring that are shaped by the life stages of the victims and offenders themselves across time

Gruber, Rosa. (2021). Factores de riesgo y conductas de riesgo en la adolescencia. Madrid: Síntesis.

En la etapa de la adolescencia y primera juventud surgen ciertas conductas desadaptadas, algunas resultan novedosas, como las apuestas o el abuso de internet, y otras son más conocidas, como el uso de drogas o la conducta antisocial. Estas conductas van desapareciendo, en la mayoría de las personas según van integrándose en la vida adulta, sin embargo, en otras se mantienen hasta convertirse en conductas de riesgo y, además, en ciertos casos persisten y mutan en problemas estables como la adicción. El paso hacia las conductas de riesgo obedece a la influencia de diversos factores denominados "de riesgo". Este libro describe los factores que facilitan el paso a conductas de riesgo, los que protegen del riesgo y cómo se articulan entre sí, finalizando con la propuesta de actuar sobre los elementos comunes a diversas conductas.

Linking the behavioral immune system to COVID-19 vaccination intention: The mediating role of the need for cognitive closure and vaccine hesitancy.

Abstract: Vaccination has become one of the most effective ways of controlling the spread of COVID-19. Consequently, revealing the evolutionary and cognitive antecedents of COVID-19 vaccine hesitancy and vaccination intention has become crucial. Drawing on the theory of behavioral immune system (BIS), we investigate whether perceived vulnerability to disease (PVD) is associated with vaccination intentions through the need for cognitive closure (NCC) and vaccine hesitancy. The data was collected from 525 adults from Turkey. The structural equation modeling results indicate that of the two dimensions of PVD, germ aversion predicts COVID-19 vaccination intention through sequential mediation of NCC and vaccine hesitancy. Perceived infectability, on the other hand, is directly and positively related to vaccination intention. By showing the mediating role of NCC, our results offer an insight as to why germ aversion translates into vaccine hesitancy, and low vaccination intention. We discuss the potential benefits of considering the roles of BIS and NCC in campaigns and policies targeted at increasing COVID-19 vaccine uptake and suggest implications for such practices.
